

Civil Reabsorption Office

Under the Office of the Chief Secretariat, Kampala

The Civil Reabsorption Office operated under the Office of the Chief Secretariat during and in the immediate aftermath of World War II, from approximately 1944 through 1947. The majority of files in this small collection address the payment, demobilization, and training for post-War employment of soldiers and askaris. In addition, the Civil Reabsorption Office also handled certain files about the settlement and employment of wartime refugees, though the bulk of files on Polish refugees are to be found in the Secretariat Papers. Given the short timeframe of the Civil Reabsorption Office's operation, this is presently the smallest collection catalogued at the Uganda National Archives.
